## 2018 Summer Breakfast & Lunch Program

This summer the Hamburg School will be providing a summer breakfast and lunch program free to all children age 2 to 18. The meals will be served in the lunchroom at the Hamburg School. Students are to enter using the south doors — the school's main entrance.

Meal dates & Times: <u>Monday through Friday in June & July</u>, beginning on Monday, June 4th and through Friday, June 29th. In July, we will serve on Monday, July 9th — the last day we will serve for the summer will be Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. Breakfast will be served from 9:00 to 9:30 a.m. and lunch will be served from 12:15 to 12:45 p.m. >>> We will NOT serve the week of July 2<sup>nd</sup> thru July 6<sup>th</sup> due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Holiday!

A town bus route will run each day for both breakfast and lunch. Children who would like to ride the bus/van, need to be at one of the following stops: \*\* L & Main, Golden Acres-park area, Holt's, Catholic Church, Trinity Church, Swimming Pool or the South Park. \*\* These bus stops will also be used for the Summer Enrichment Program. To ride for breakfast, children need to be at the bus/van stop by 8:45 a.m. To ride for lunch, children need to be at the bus stop by 12:00 noon. Students will need to be at the bus stop on time. Because of the tight schedule the driver will not be able to wait for students.

After breakfast the bus/van will leave the school at 9:31 a.m. After lunch the bus/van will leave the school at 12:46 p.m. and run the route in the same order students were picked up.

Remember that it is a privilege to come and eat. Please do not abuse this privilege! The school does not have to allow any student to attend the summer program if they are misbehaving or unruly. The site supervisor is in charge of discipline in the cafeteria.

The first time that a student has a disciplinary problem, the site supervisor will give the student a warning. The second time the student has a problem the supervisor will ask the student to immediately leave the school and not return that day. The third time the student has a problem, the student will be asked to leave the school immediately and not return for the remainder of the summer. The supervisor will keep a discipline log to keep track of these three steps. **This will be enforced.** If you do not like the rules, please do not attend!
